

Camp Overview

Camps are designed for Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced riders with a certified head instructor (American Riding Instructors Association and U.S. Eventing Association) to accommodate the skill sets. We provide quality school horse paired for each rider, or campers may bring their own horses for an additional boarding fee of \$25 per day. A.S.T.M./S.E.I. approved helmets are required for riders. (we supply if needed) Shoes with a heel required for riding. Tennis shoes required for all other activities. Campers will need to pack a lunch. Refreshments provided (drinks and snacks). Each participant will receive a group photo and a certificate of merit for horsemanship. Last day of each camp is "Friends and Family Day!" Campers will ride horses and perform an exhibition for everyone starting at 2:30 pm.

Camp Objective

To provide a fun, challenging and safe environment in which to teach children about horses. Instruction in correct equitation, the fundamentals of horse/pony care, and stable management practices. Daily activities consist of riding lessons (hunt seat equitation, dressage, cross country jumping, show jumping) crafts, other sports such as volleyball and kickball. Many interesting equestrian topics will be covered during camp week that may include: equine dentistry, basic veterinary care, a farrier visit, and participation in our "Camp Demonstration" at the end of the week.



At Windy Meadows Farm we pride ourselves in hosting a camp that your child will remember for a lifetime. With safety being our number one concern, we have a very low child/counselor ratio and usually have one counselor to every two children. Our camps are from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily with before or after care provided if needed at a minimal charge.

Camp activities include daily riding lessons, horse education, daily horse management, horse care and horse safety lessons, interaction with miniature horses, miniature donkeys, our new addition Zonkey (his mommy was a donkey, daddy is a zebra, two pet miniature pigs, rabbits, and our newest addition *Newt* the camel! Other activities the children will enjoy are canoeing, daily arts and crafts, horse games (on and off the horse) and the chance to meet new friends both two and four legged.

We provide snacks and drinks, campers bring their own bagged lunch and everyone will get a limo ride to eat their picnic lunch at the "Chuckwagon" Restaurant in Nokesville owned by your host! All ages 8–16 are welcome and every level of experience from total beginner to experienced riders. Our facilities include a huge indoor ring and pavilion so fun will be had regardless of the weather.



Other Important Information

Beforecare is available 7:30–9:00 a.m. or aftercare is available 4:00–6:00 p.m. \$50 per week per morning or per evening or \$100 for both. Monday thru Friday camp is \$400 per session for five days. You also may pay \$275 for any three days of camp. A waiver/consent form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian if under 18. Space is limited to 12 campers per week. A deposit of \$100 per camper is required with this application. Balance is due one week before camp. Deposits are non-refundable and there is a \$30 return check fee.
